
Please enter into the congressional record that the Newton County Quorum Court supports the Shaddox Cemetery Association proposal as the lawful solution to this boundary dispute, based on the enabling legislation for the Buffalo National River. (See PL 92-237; USC 16, Ch. 1; 460m-8; 4601-9(c)(2); 4601-22(b) PL 90-401 Sec.5(b))

We also agree with the Shaddox Cemetery Association that the congressional committees that are charged with the oversight of such matters need to pay us a visit and witness first hand what is actually going on.


Please give immediate attention to this official request for as soon as possible in November *after* the general election, that a joint congressional field hearing be arranged at the Shaddox Cemetery pavilion with the U.S. Senate Committee on Energy and Natural Resources and the U.S. House Committee on Resources. If the weather is too inclement at that time to sustain a lengthy meeting at their outdoor cemetery pavilion, we shall be happy to accommodate the committees in our Newton County Courthouse for follow-up discussion *after* their on site visit at the location of the cemetery.


